DOMINANT SPECIES

Grand Fir (*Abies grandis*)



DESCRIPTION

Conifer forest dominated by grand fir (*Abies grandis*) with 20-100% cover. Associated shrub species: huckleberry (*Vaccinium spp.*), mountain lover (*Pachistima myrsinites*), thimbleberry (*Rubus parviflorum*), twin flower (*Linnaea borealis*). Associated grass and forb species: queens cup beadlily (*Clintonia uniflora*).

STATE RANGE

Occurs only in western Montana. Usually located near or in riparian areas at low elevation forest sites.
